BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 153
Series of 2012

SUBJECT: GRANTING EXEMPTION FROM SPECIFIC MEASURES OF REGULATORY CONTROL REQUIREMENTS TO CERTAIN FINISHED PRODUCTS OF BLUE LAZER CORPORATION

WHEREAS, under Section 81 (b) and (r) of Article IX of RA 9165, otherwise known as the Comprehensive Dangerous Drugs Act of 2002, the Board issued Board Regulation No. 3, Series of 2003 which provides for the “Comprehensive Guidelines on Importation, Distribution, Manufacture, Prescription, Dispensing and Sale of, and Other Lawful Acts in Connection with any Dangerous Drugs, Controlled Precursors and Essential Chemicals and other Similar or Analogous Substances”;

WHEREAS, **BLUE LAZER CORPORATION**, with business address at 178-B Del Monte Avenue, SFDM, Quezon City, Philippines is seeking exemption from regulatory measures to the following products containing controlled chemicals, to wit:

1. **SHIN EZ FLIP-FLOP CONTROLLER – 2 -5% Toluene**
2. **SHIN EZ 2K HARDENER - 10-15% Toluene**
3. **SHIN EZ 2K V2 CLEAR HARDENER – 10-15% Toluene**
4. **SHIN EZ 2K CLEAR V2 (BASE) – 20-25% Toluene**
5. **METALACT H15 (ADDITIVE) – 15-25% Toluene**
6. **SHIN EZ SK 2K PRIMER SURFACER DARK GREY – 5-10% Toluene**
7. **SHIN EZ SK 2K PRIMER SURFACER LIGHT GREY (FAST DRY)
– 5-10% Toluene**
8. **SHIN EZ SUPER FAST DARK GREY PRIMER – 5-10% Toluene;
5-10% MEK**
9. **SHIN EZ SUPER FAST MEDIUM GREY PRIMER - 5-10% Toluene;
5-10% MEK**
10. **SHIN EZ SUPER FAST LIGHT GREY PRIMER – 5-10% Toluene;
5-10% MEK**
11. **2K MONO COAT HARDENER – 10-15% Toluene**
12. **SHIN EZ 2K BINDER – 2-5% Toluene**

WHEREAS, Section 4(2c,-d, e & f), Article II of the same Regulation also provides that the Board may exempt from specific measures of regulatory control requirements any preparation with liquid chemical mixture containing less than 30% by weight of the Table II chemical; or solid, semisolid and highly viscous chemical mixture containing Table II chemical; or when the Board is satisfied that the mixture is formulated in such a way that the controlled chemical cannot be easily used for the illicit manufacture of a dangerous drug and that the controlled chemical or chemicals contained in the mixture cannot be readily recovered;

WHEREAS, to assist the Board in evaluating requests for exemption, it promulgated Board Resolution No.1 Series of 2008 entitled “**Creating a Technical**

Working Group (TWG) to assist the Board in considering request of Manufacturers and Importers of finished products from specific measures of regulatory control requirements”;

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the DDB Technical Working Group (TWG) that **Blue Lazer Corp.** known as Sapphire Commercial has been established in 1983 in Del Monte, Q.C. and is wholly owned corporation by the David family. The company started in distributing car alarm and later expanded into automotive industry (refinishing/manufacturing) such as paints from Japan like kansai Paints and supplied such paints to various plants and facilities. **It is duly registered with PDEA and handler of P5I-00935001-N008 issued on 04 April 2012 and valid until 30 March 2013;**

WHEREAS, after satisfying the requirements under the above mentioned regulations, that **BLUE LAZER CORPORATION** products are no longer covered by the provisions of **Section 10 (Application for import, export or transit permits), Section 11 (Grant of import, export or transit permits), and Section 22 (Licensed operators NOT to deal with unlicensed operators) of BR No.3, S. 2003;**

WHEREAS, after due deliberation and evaluation, the TWG decided to recommend to the Board the exemption of that **BLUE LAZER CORPORATION products** that are below the 30% threshold of the Table II chemicals, in accordance with the provisions of Section 4-2(d & f);

WHEREFORE, be it **RESOLVED**, as it is hereby **RESOLVED**:

- a. **TO GRANT EXEMPTION** and the issuance of a Certificate of Exemption, which shall be valid for one (1) year unless revoked, to that **BLUE LAZER CORPORATION** products that contain controlled chemical below the 30% threshold of the Table II chemicals, in accordance with the provisions of Section 4-2(d & f):
- b. **That the above cited exemptions shall be subject to the following conditions:**
 - (1) The, **BLUE LAZER CORPORATION** shall secure a license from the PDEA and comply with the reporting requirements for the raw materials used in the manufacture of the products, as provided for in Board Regulation No. 3, Series of 2003;
 - (2) The Board shall strictly monitor subject finished products from their importation to distribution to end-users;
 - (3) The DDB-PDEA Monitoring Team shall have free access to the that **BLUE LAZER CORPORATION** premises where the finished products are kept and/or used;
 - (4) The **BLUE LAZER CORPORATION** shall assume full responsibility for any misuse of the imported finished products, caused either by its own negligence or by negligence of all persons acting under their name or control and supervision; and
 - (5) Any violation of the provisions of Board Regulation No. 3, Series of 2003, shall be a ground for the revocation of the certificate of exemption at anytime and would be dealt with severely.
