**BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 6
Series of 2021**

SUBJECT: ADOPTION OF THE KATATAGAN, KALUSUGAN AT DAMAYAN NG KOMUNIDAD (KKDK) PROGRAM, AS A COMMUNITY-BASED AFTERCARE AND REINTEGRATION MODEL

WHEREAS, paragraph 1 of Section 2 of R.A. 9165, as amended, states among others that: “It is the policy of the State to safeguard the integrity of its territory and the well-being of its citizenry particularly the youth, from the harmful effects of dangerous drugs on their physical and mental well-being, and to defend the same against acts or omissions detrimental to their development and preservation.”;

WHEREAS, paragraph 3 of the same Section provides that “It is further declared the policy of the State to provide effective mechanisms or measures to re-integrate into society individuals who have fallen victims to drug abuse or dangerous drug dependence through sustainable programs of treatment and rehabilitation.”;

WHEREAS, Section 77 of the said Act identifies the Board as “the policy-making and strategy-formulating body in the planning and formulation of policies and programs on drug prevention and control”;

WHEREAS, paragraph (h) of Section 81 of the same Act mandates the Board to “Design and develop, in consultation and coordination with the DOH, DSWD and other agencies involved in drugs control, treatment and rehabilitation, both public and private, a national treatment and rehabilitation program for drug dependents including a standard aftercare and community service program for recovering drug dependents”;

WHEREAS, to complement the ongoing campaign against illegal drugs of President Rodrigo Roa Duterte, the Board issued Regulation No. 4, Series of 2016 calling for the implementation of community-based treatment and rehabilitation programs in Local Government Units (LGUs) in order to introduce appropriate interventions to individuals who have low to mild substance use disorder;


WHEREAS, during the 193rd Regular Board Meeting (7th Special Online Session) on 29 April 2021, the Katatagan, Kalusugan at Damayan ng Komunidad (KKDK) Program, developed by the Psychological Association of the Philippines and the USAID RenewHealth Project, which is a community-based drug rehabilitation program with aftercare and reintegration model for Persons Who Use Drugs (PWUDs), was presented and explained.

WHEREFORE, be it **RESOLVED**, as it is hereby **RESOLVED**, to adopt the Katatagan, Kalusugan at Damayan ng Komunidad (KKDK) Program as one of the models for Local Government Units in the implementation of their respective community-based drug rehabilitation programs.
