**BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 1
Series of 2022**

SUBJECT: INCLUSION OF ADDITIONAL ANNEXES TO BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 18, SERIES OF 2020, ON THE ADOPTION OF THE DSWD YAKAP BAYAN PROGRAM (YBP) AS A COMMUNITY-BASED AFTERCARE AND REINTEGRATION MODEL

WHEREAS, paragraph 1 of Section 2 (Declaration of Policy) of R.A. 9165, as amended, states among others that: "It is the policy of the State to safeguard the integrity of its territory and the well-being of its citizenry particularly the youth, from the harmful effects of dangerous drugs on their physical and mental well-being, and to defend the same against acts or omissions detrimental to their development and preservation";

WHEREAS, paragraph 3 of the same Section provides that "It is further declared the policy of the State to provide effective mechanisms or measures to re-integrate into society individuals who have fallen victims to drug abuse or dangerous drug dependence through sustainable programs of treatment and rehabilitation";

WHEREAS, Section 77 (The Dangerous Drugs Board) of the said Act identifies the Board as "the policy-making and strategy-formulating body in the planning and formulation of policies and programs on drug prevention and control";

WHEREAS, sub-paragraph (h) of Section 81 (Powers and Duties of the Board) of the same Act mandates the Board to "Design and develop, in consultation and coordination with the DOH, DSWD and other agencies involved in drugs control, treatment and rehabilitation, both public and private, a national treatment and rehabilitation program for drug dependents including a standard aftercare and community service program for recovering drug dependents";

WHEREAS, the present focus of treatment and rehabilitation of drug users and dependents is through community-based drug rehabilitation programs implemented by the Local Government Units (LGUs);

WHEREAS, on 17 November 2020, the Board issued the aforementioned Board Resolution on the DSWD YAKAP BAYAN PROGRAM (YBP) adopting it as a community-based aftercare and reintegration model, with its Implementing Guidelines attached thereto as Annex "A";

WHEREAS, during the 10th Special Online Session (196th Regular Meeting) of the Board on 22 June 2022, two (2) proposed additional annexes (Aftercare Modules and Aftercare Workbook) were presented and explained to the Board for possible inclusion in the said Board Resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it **RESOLVED**, as it is hereby **RESOLVED**, to include as additional annexes to Board Resolution No. 18, Series of 2020, the Aftercare Modules (Annex B) and Aftercare Workbook (Annex C), copies of which are attached hereto and form part of this document.
