

FOR THE CONDUCT OF THE 2015 NATIONWIDE SURVEY ON THE NATURE AND
EXTENT OF DRUG ABUSE IN THE PHILIPPINES

EVALUATION CRITERIA

The track record, experiences of the firm, and the education, skill level and work experiences of the technical staff shall be evaluated in order to select the most suitable to conduct the 2015 Nationwide Survey on the Nature and Extent of Drug Abuse in the Philippines. The criteria are as follows:

1. PLAN OF APPROACH AND METHODOLOGY

40%

- Understanding of objectives (The extent to which the firm shows an understanding of the objectives, requirements and outputs of the project)
- Quality of methodology (It must show clearly in complete, logical and creative manner how the firm proposes to carry out the project)
- The company's proposal must provide evidence of clear understanding of the technical requirements and the magnitude of the Terms of Reference (TOR) scope of work.
- Proposal Presentation (accuracy, completeness and ease of reference)

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2. CAPABILITY AND EXPERIENCE OF THE FIRM

30%

- Consulting firm must have an experience in the conduct of a nationwide survey or related nature for at least five (5) years.
- Consulting firm must include in the proposal and capability of the personnel who will handle the data gathering activities. Its personnel must possess the necessary knowledge, experience, and education in the total spectrum of activities pertaining to the conduct of a nationwide survey.
- Provision of a staffing plan to provide the manpower availability/allocations to assure that the requirements of the TOR is timely met.

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3. QUALIFICATION AND COMPETENCE OF THE
TECHNICAL STAFF FOR THE ASSIGNMENT

30%

- Educational Background
- Project-related experience
- Relevant training attended

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
