**REQUEST FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST FOR
PROCUREMENT OF CONSULTING SERVICES FOR
2015 NATIONWIDE SURVEY ON THE NATURE AND
EXTENT OF DRUG ABUSE IN THE PHILIPPINES**

1. The DANGEROUS DRUGS BOARD, through the General Appropriations Act (GAA) 2015 intends to apply the sum of EIGHT MILLION PESOS (P8,000,000.00) being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payments under the contract for Procurement of Consulting Services for 2015 Nationwide Survey on the Nature and Extent of Drug Abuse in the Philippines. Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at the opening of the financial proposals.
2. The DANGEROUS DRUGS BOARD now calls for the submission of eligibility documents for the conduct of the survey to assess the current drug situation of the country. Interested consultants must submit their eligibility documents on or before April 27, 2015 at 9:00 AM at the DDB Conference Room, 3/F PDEA Building, NIA Road, Brgy. Pinyahan, Quezon City. Applications for eligibility will be evaluated based on a non-discretionary "pass/fail" criterion.
3. The BAC shall draw up the short list of consultants from those who have submitted eligibility documents and have been determined as eligible in accordance with the provisions of Republic Act 9184 (RA 9184), otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act", and its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR). The short list shall consist of at least five (5) prospective bidders who will be entitled to submit bids. The criteria and rating system for short listing are:

I.	Applicable Experience of the consulting firm	50%
II.	Qualification of principal and key staff to be assigned	30%
III.	Current workload relative to capacity	20%
Total		100%


4. Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using non-discretionary "pass/fail" criterion as specified in the IRR of RA 9184.

Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, partnerships, or organizations with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines.

5. The Procuring Entity shall evaluate bids using the *Quality Based Evaluation/Selection (QBE/QBS)* The Procuring Entity shall indicate the weights to be allocated for the Technical and Financial Proposals The criteria and rating system for the evaluation of bids shall be provided in the Instructions to Bidder.
6. The contract shall be completed within 120 days or 4 months.
7. The DANGEROUS DRUGS BOARD reserves the right to reject any and all bids, annul the bidding process, or not award the contract at any time prior to contract award, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders.
