**BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 13
Series of 2022**

SUBJECT: APPROVING THE RENEWAL OF THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA) BETWEEN THE DANGEROUS DRUGS BOARD (DDB) AND THE UNIVERSITY OF THE PHILIPPINES – DILIMAN (UP-DILIMAN) ON THE ASEAN TRAINING CENTER FOR PREVENTIVE DRUG EDUCATION (ATCPDE)

WHEREAS, the Board is the policy-making and strategy-formulating body in the planning and formulation of policies and programs on drug prevention and control which shall develop and adopt a comprehensive, integrated, unified and balanced national drug abuse prevention and control strategy;

WHEREAS, the Association of South East Asian Countries (ASEAN), which includes the Philippines, recognized that the drug problem in the ASEAN Region is a complex and multifaceted issue and agreed to establish the ASEAN Training Center for Preventive Drug Education (ATCPDE);

WHEREAS, during the 4th Meeting of the ASEAN Drug Experts in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia in 1979, it was recommended and approved that the ATCPDE be based in the University of the Philippines Diliman on account that the said university has been providing leadership to ASEAN countries on training programs in preventive drug education since 1973;

WHEREAS, the present MOA on the ATCPDE between the DDB and UP-Diliman entered into in January 2020 will be expiring in December 2022 and needs to be renewed.

WHEREFORE, be it **RESOLVED**, as it is hereby **RESOLVED**, to approve the renewal of the MOA between the DDB and UP-Diliman on the ATCPDE.
