**BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 4
Series of 2022**

SUBJECT: APPROVING THE PROVISION OF FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FROM THE SPECIAL ACCOUNT IN THE GENERAL FUND OF THE BOARD TO GOVERNMENT TREATMENT AND REHABILITATION CENTERS AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT COMMUNITY-BASED TREATMENT AND REHABILITATION FACILITIES FOR CY 2022

WHEREAS, Section 75 of Republic Act No. 9165 or the Comprehensive Dangerous Drugs Act of 2002 provides that the Board shall support the establishment of government-operated regional treatment and rehabilitation centers and shall give priority funding for the increase of subsidy to existing government drug rehabilitation centers;

WHEREAS, Section 87 of Republic Act No. 9165 and its Implementing Rules and Regulations provides for the creation of a Special Account in the General Fund (SAGF) in favor of the Board;

WHEREAS, the aforesaid provision authorizes the Board to extend financial assistance to drug treatment and rehabilitation centers owned and operated by the National Government and its political subdivisions, including establishment and maintenance of new drug treatment and rehabilitation centers in the country as well as the operation and maintenance of existing ones;

WHEREAS, the Board issued Regulation No. 7, Series of 2019 pertaining to the consolidated and updated procedures on the implementation of community-based treatment and rehabilitation programs in local government units for persons who use drugs with low risk to moderate risk substance use disorder;

WHEREAS, it has been recommended that release of financial assistance for 2022 from the SAGF be made for the benefit of selected government in-patient rehabilitation centers and local government community-based treatment and rehabilitation programs which requested for such assistance.

WHEREFORE, be it **RESOLVED**, as it is hereby **RESOLVED**, to approve the recommendation for the release of financial assistance from the SAGF to government

treatment and rehabilitation centers and local government units with community-based treatment and rehabilitation programs listed in Annex "A" of this Resolution.
