**BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 5
Series of 2022**

SUBJECT: AUTHORIZING THE PHILIPPINE DRUG ENFORCEMENT AGENCY TO IMPLEMENT THE ORDERS OF THE HEALTH FACILITIES AND SERVICES REGULATORY BUREAU (HFSRB) OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH

WHEREAS, Section 81(j) of Republic Act No. 9165 empowers the Dangerous Drugs Board to initiate and authorize closure proceedings against non-accredited and/or substandard rehabilitation centers based on verified reports of human rights violations, subhuman conditions, inadequate medical training and assistance and excessive fees;

WHEREAS, the same provision provides that the implementation thereof shall be undertaken by the Philippine Drug Enforcement Agency (PDEA) upon authority of the Board;

WHEREAS, there is a need to promulgate this Resolution in order to fast track the implementation by the PDEA of the decision and/or order of the Health Facilities and Services Regulatory Bureau (HFSRB) of the Department of Health without need of issuing individual resolutions per decision and/or order;

NOW THEREFORE, be it **RESOLVED**, as it is hereby **RESOLVED** that the Philippine Drug Enforcement Agency, pursuant to Section 81(j) of Republic Act No. 9165, is given the authority to implement the lawful and final orders of the Health Facilities and Services Regulatory Bureau of the Department of Health concerning treatment and rehabilitation centers;

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the request for implementation is officially indorsed by the HFSRB to PDEA, copy furnished the Board, with the following attachments: (a) Order of the HFSRB; (b) Certificate of Finality; (c) Decision of the HFSRB; (d) Investigation Report; and (e) other relevant documents;

RESOLVED FURTHERMORE, that the PDEA shall submit the corresponding reports to DDB through the Legal Affairs Division on the details of the implementation;

RESOLVED FINALLY, that the Board may seek the assistance of the local police force and/or the local government operations officer in monitoring the compliance of the concerned treatment and rehabilitation center in his/her area of responsibility on the order of the HFSRB implemented by the PDEA.
