**BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 16
SERIES OF 2025**

SUBJECT: A RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND RECOGNIZING THE OUTSTANDING ACCOMPLISHMENTS OF PHILIPPINE LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES IN THE ARREST OF DRUG OFFENDERS AND SEIZURE OF ILLEGAL DRUGS

WHEREAS, Section 4, Article II of the 1987 Philippine Constitution states, among others that, "The prime duty of the Government is to serve and protect the people";

WHEREAS, Section 5, Article II of the same Constitution further states that, "The maintenance of peace and order, the protection of life, liberty, and property, and the promotion of the general welfare are essential for the enjoyment by all the people of the blessings of democracy";

WHEREAS, in furtherance of these constitutional mandates, Republic Act No. 9165, also known as the Comprehensive Dangerous Drugs Act of 2002, as amended, designates the Dangerous Drugs Board (DDB) as the policy-making and strategy-formulating body responsible for the development of programs on drug prevention and control;

WHEREAS, in pursuit of this mandate, Executive Order No. 66, Series of 2018, entitled "Institutionalization of the Philippine Anti-Illegal Drugs Strategy (PADS)," was issued, establishing a national framework for combating illegal drugs with a focus on both drug supply reduction and drug demand reduction as its two (2) main pillars;

WHEREAS, the Philippine Government, through its law enforcement agencies, remains steadfast in its commitment to suppress the proliferation of illegal drugs and dismantle drug trafficking networks nationwide;

WHEREAS, recent law enforcement operations have resulted in significant arrests and unprecedented seizures of various illegal drugs, particularly methamphetamine hydrochloride (*shabu*), reflecting a heightened level of inter-agency coordination and operational effectiveness;

WHEREAS, these accomplishments were achieved through the collective efforts of law enforcement agencies led by the Philippine Drug Enforcement Agency (PDEA), in close coordination with the Philippine National Police (PNP), Bureau of Customs (BOC), National Bureau of Investigation (NBI), Department of National Defense (DND), Philippine Coast Guard (PCG), and other partner agencies that actively participated in these operations;

WHEREAS, the collective efforts of the PDEA, PNP, NBI, BOC, DND, PCG, and other law enforcement agencies underscore a unified commitment to the national anti-

drug campaign and have significantly disrupted the illegal drug supply chains that threaten the safety and well-being of the nation;

WHEREAS, these remarkable achievements were made possible through coordinated intelligence-driven operations and a whole-of-nation approach, in line with the directive of the President to enhance interagency collaboration for effective drug law enforcement;

WHEREAS, during the 207th Regular Meeting of the Board held on 12 December 2025, the Board agreed to acknowledge and recognize the outstanding accomplishments of the concerned law enforcement agencies in the successful conduct of anti-illegal drug operations aimed at disrupting and dismantling the supply of dangerous drugs in the country for CY 2025 which resulted to PHP47.80 billion worth of dangerous drugs seizures including notable big hauls from nationwide operations such as 6.59 tons of methamphetamine hydrochloride or shabu worth PHP44.83 billion, 174,347.56 grams of cocaine worth PHP924 million, 24,860 ecstasy tablets worth PHP42 million, 546,102.92 grams of marijuana kush worth PHP655 million, 1,850,610.88 grams of dried marijuana leaves and bricks worth PHP222 million, 515,698.19 grams of marijuana stalks worth PHP62 million, 147,907.99 grams of marijuana fruiting tops worth PHP18 million, 4,899,543 marijuana plants worth PHP980 million, and 183,257 marijuana seedlings worth PHP7.3 million ¹;

NOW THEREFORE, be it **RESOLVED**, as it is hereby **RESOLVED**, that the Dangerous Drugs Board commend and recognize the outstanding accomplishments of the Philippine Drug Enforcement Agency, including the Philippine National Police, Bureau of Customs, National Bureau of Investigation, Department of National Defense, Philippine Coast Guard, and other partner agencies that actively participated in these law enforcement operations for their significant accomplishments in drug supply reduction efforts, and for advancing a strategy that strengthens law enforcement actions while safeguarding human rights and promoting public safety.
